The City Council of the City of Lavaca met for a regular monthly meeting Monday May 8, 2017, at City Hall in Lavaca. Board members present were Mayor Hugh Hardgrave; Aldermen: Mike Ray, Rick Edgerton, Jeff Price, Dale Teague, Randy Overbey, Benny Hunter, attorney John Verkamp, and Recorder Shelly Hockaday. Visitors present were Ken VanDusen, Steve Helms and Randy Toon.

The meeting was called to order at 7 P. M. Hugh Hardgrave led the Pledge of Allegiance and Steve Helms led the prayer.

The Council approved the minutes of the April regular meeting as printed. (JP/DT)

Council members reviewed the report from the Police Dept. The Department answered 486 calls in April. Additionally, 59 traffic stops resulted in 11 traffic tickets, 9 criminal ticket and 50 warnings. There were 14 arrests made in the month of April.

Council members reviewed the report from the Fire Dept. The Department responded to 10 first responder calls, 1 fire call, and 1 vehicle accident.

Council members voted all in favor of passing a Resolution for District Court in Greenwood to destroy documents during the time frame specified by the courts. (RE/ BH)

Council members voted all in favor of passing a Resolution to support the designation of the United States Postal Service Facility located at 504 West Main in Lavaca, Arkansas, as the "J.C. 'Jake' Patterson Post Office". (MR/ DT) This is a step in the process in the renaming of the Post Office. This resolution will be forwarded to Congressman John Boozman so he can then proceed to the next step in the process.

The Council voted to pay the bills for the month of May. (RE/ MR)

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
