The City Council of the City of Lavaca met for a special meeting Monday September 25, 2017, at City Hall in Lavaca. Board members present were Mayor Hugh Hardgrave; Aldermen: Mike Ray, Rick Edgerton, Jeff Price, Dale Teague, Randy Overbey, Benny Hunter and Recorder Shelly Hockaday. Visitors present were Ken VanDusen and Larry Yancey.

The meeting was called to order at 7 P. M.

Mr. Yancey presented a bid recap for the Dogwood Street Project from Franklin to Davis. This project will include relocating the water line, widening and resurfacing the street and a new sidewalk. Council reviewed the bids and heard comments from Mr. Yancey about the references. Mayor Hardgrave made a recommendation that we accept the low bid of \$108,248.73 from HardRock Construction, Inc. Rick Edgerton made a motion to accept the bid and Benny Hunter seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Motion passed.
