## June 9, 2025

The City Council of the City of Lavaca met for a regular monthly meeting Monday June 9, 2025, at City Hall in Lavaca. Board members present were Mayor Hugh Hardgrave, Aldermen: Mike Ray, Gerald Schaeffer, Mac Green, Lisa Hogan, Lorie Robertson, Dawn Hutchins, City Attorney John Verkamp and Recorder Shelly Hockaday. Visitors present were Jeremy Smith, Kirk Barber, Randy Toon, Dwayne Wallace, Zena Chinos and Andy Hanna.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 P. M. Lorie Robertson led the Pledge of Allegiance and Hugh Hardgrave led the prayer.

The Council reviewed the minutes of the May regular meeting. Lorie Robertson made a motion to approve the meeting minutes as printed. Lisa Hogan seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Motion passed.

Council members reviewed the report from the Police Dept. The Department performed 451 activities in May. LPD issued 8 tickets and 29 warnings. There were 2 arrests made in the month of May.

Council members reviewed the report from the Fire Dept. They responded to: 13 fire calls and 25 EMS calls in May.

Agenda Item #1 – Consider contract amendment for North Davis Street engineering. Council members reviewed a proposal from McClelland Consulting Engineers, Inc. to provide services during construction in the amount of \$25,000. Gerald Schaefer made a motion to approve the amendment. Mike Ray seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Motion passed.

Agenda Item #2 – Consider city park improvements for the basketball court and the parking gravel parking area. Council discussed the project and reviewed bids from Shayne Ellison Concrete, LLC. Bid 1 was for \$15,477 to tear out, dispose of old concrete and replace basketball court. Bid 2 was for \$10,640 to remove gravel, prep and pour concrete parking in front of the basketball court. Mike Ray made a motion to approve both bids and proceed with the project. Dawn Hutchins seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Motion passed.

Gerald Schaefer made a motion to pay the bills for the month of June. Lorie Robertson seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Motion passed.

Gerald Schaefer made a motion to adjourn. Lisa Hogan seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Meeting was adjourned.
