The City Council of the City of Lavaca met for a regular monthly meeting Monday May 13, 2019, at City Hall in Lavaca. Board members present were Mayor Hugh Hardgrave; Aldermen: Mike Ray, Gerald Schaefer, Rick Edgerton, Dale Teague, Lorie Robertson, attorney John Verkamp and Recorder Shelly Hockaday. Benny Hunter was absent. Visitors present were Butch Maness, Steve Helms, Ken VanDusen, Renee Myers, and Randy Toon.

The meeting was called to order at 7 P. M. Mayor Hugh Hardgrave led the Pledge of Allegiance and Steve Helms led the prayer.

The Council approved the minutes of the April regular meeting as printed. (RE/GS)

Council members reviewed the report from the Police Dept. The Department answered 413 calls in April and made 8 arrests. Additionally, 13 tickets and 27 warnings were issued.

Council members reviewed the report from the Fire Dept. The Department responded to 26 first responder calls and 3 fire calls.
