The City Council of the City of Lavaca met for a regular monthly meeting Monday January 10, 2022, at City Hall in Lavaca. Board members present were Mayor Hugh Hardgrave, Aldermen: Mike Ray, Gerald Schaeffer, Rick Edgerton, Lorie Robertson, Benny Hunter, City Attorney John Verkamp and Recorder Shelly Hockaday. The Council reviewed the minutes of the December regular meeting. Gerald Schaeffer made a motion to approve the minutes as printed. Benny Hunter seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Motion passed.

Council members reviewed the report from the Police Dept. The Department answered 554 calls in December. LPD issued 7 tickets and 9 warnings. There were 3 arrests made in the month of December.

Council members reviewed maps for new wards based on the new census numbers. After much discussion and advised from John Verkamp Lorie Robertson made a motion to table this item for a later date. Rick Edgerton seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Motion Passed.

Council members discussed the disposal of the old pumper. Gerald Schaeffer made a motion we accept sealed bids for it when the fire dept has gotten everything off of it and are ready to sell it. Mike Ray seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Motion Passed.

Lorie Robertson made a motion to pay the bills for the month of January. Gerald Schaeffer seconded the motion and all voted in favor. Motion passed.
